



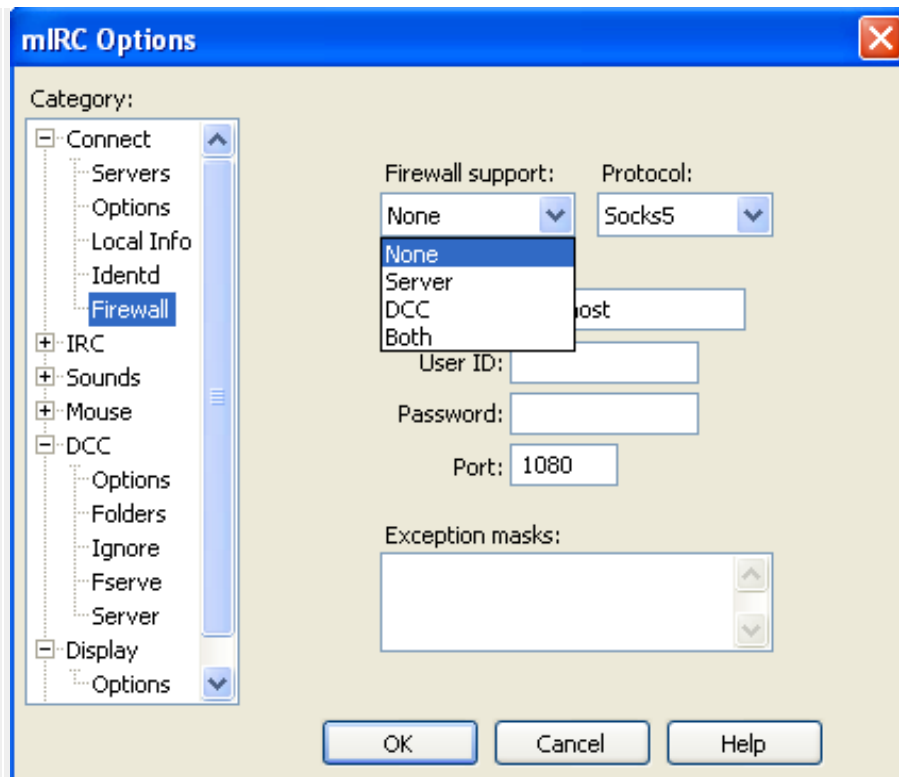

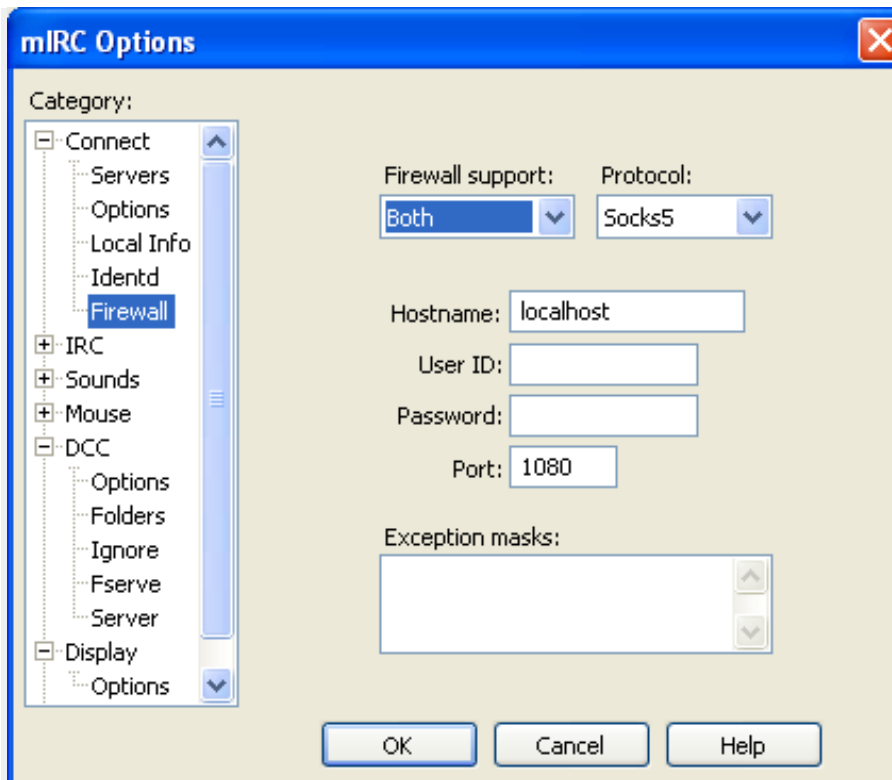

Open mIRC 2. The mIRC options window should pop up, if not click on File -> Select Server 3. Click on Firewall in the Connect Section of the Options window. 4. Now you have 3 options, Server, DCC and Both <p> Server: only uses the proxy server during the host connections DCC: Only uses the proxy during client to client transfers Both: Uses the proxy for everything in mIRC (Recommended) </p>



5. Select your choice from #4 and enter:

- Protocol: SOCKS5
- Hostname: localhost
- Port: 1080
- Rest is blank



6. Click on OK

7. Connect as usual.

NOTE: I have had some problems arising from Ident server issues going through HTTP-Tunnel, so some servers might not connect. This should be fixed in a future build so just hang tight if it isn't working.
